- financed by the EU and implemented by the Directorate for EU Affairs in collaboration with the Central Finance and Contracts Unit and the Delegation of the European Union to Turkey

Who can apply?

- Those currently working in Turkey in public sector (including the employees of the professional organizations having legal public personality, chambers and local administrations – municipalities, special provincial administrations –, development agencies, public development and investment banks, public deposit banks, etc.)
- Those currently studying as senior or graduate (master's or PhD) students in universities in Turkey
- Those currently working in universities in Turkey as academic or administrative staff
- Those currently working in private sector (including the employees of resident diplomatic missions, Non-Governmental organisations (NGOs), etc.)
